Kindergarten, Year 3 ~ Ages 5 – 6

Practical Life:	Basic Presentations, Simple to Hard, Line Activities, Silence Games, Preparation of Own Snack & Variations/Extensions of Entire Practical Life Area (pouring, spooning, stringing, twisting, tonging, folding, polishing, buttoning, tying, washing, sewing and zipping).
Sensorial:	Reading Labels, Making Patterns, All Constructive Triangle Boxes (Hexagons), Geometric Solids (with blindfold), Color Words, Binomial Cube/Trinomial Cube, Sound Cylinders & Variations/Extensions of entire Sensorial Area.
Zoology:	Vertebrates/Invertebrates, Dinosaurs, Farm/Jungle Animals, Animals from the 7 Continents, Names of Baby/Adult Animals, Parts of a Horse/Turtle, & Life Cycle of a Frog/Butterfly.
Geography:	7 Continents - Maps, Oceans, Flags, United States, Address & Phone Number, Land Formations, Earth & Planets, Compass Rose (NESW), Climates, Volcanoes, & Biomes.
Language:	All of the Structured Reading Program (red -abcfnf, yellow-himrf, green-godpj, orange-vexkl, blue-wqzuy), Reading Flashcards, Copy from Paper to Paper, Copy from Board to Paper, Command Cards, Phonograms, Intro to Cursive, Parts of Speech (nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives, etc.), Punctuation, Alphabetical order, Parts of Animal Cards, Write Entire Name, Reading Books, Creative Writing (journals), Metal Inset Design Extensions, Dictation, Movable Alphabet, & Spelling Words.
Math:	Decimal System, Teen Boards, Ten Boards, 100 Board, Large Number Cards, Static and Basic Addition, Static and Basic Multiplication, Static and Basic Division, Static and Basic Subtraction, Bank Games, Stamp Games, Addition & Subtraction Math Facts, Fractions, All Addition and Multiplication Boards, Measuring, Write numbers past 1000 & Money Work.
Motor Dev.:	Dribbling Ball, Skipping, Catching, Tossing Under Hand, Tossing Over Hand, Monkey Bars, Hang from Bars for 10-15 sec., Jump Rope, Walking Line (heel to toe), & Balance Board
History:	Telling Time (hour, half hour, quarter hour), Make Own Calendars, Planets, Past/Present/Future, Days of the Week, Months of the Year, & Knows Birthday.
Science:	Parts of the Body, Skeletal Structure, Magnifying Glass, Parts of a Flower, Parts of a Plant, Caring for Plants, Magnets, Sink/Float, Living/Non-Living, Grouping, Land/Air/Water, Science Experiments & Various Extensions of the Above.
Art:	Gluing, Cutting, Coloring in Lines with Crayons, Markers, & Colored Pencils, Pin Punching, Color By Number, Mosaics, Collages, Painting (finger, brushes, sponges, marble, etc.), Clay & Chalk.
Grace/Courtesy:	Mannerism (please/thank you/excuse me), Behaving Properly On Line/In Classroom/On Playground, Group Leader, & Respectful to Teachers and Friends.
Field Trips:	Educational Field Trips planned throughout the year.
